- Nineteen expeditions to Greenland studying impact of climate



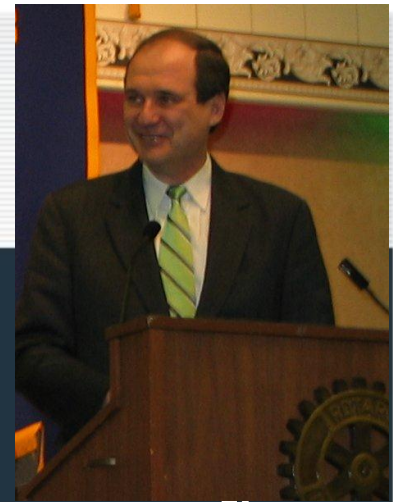
