LOGISTICS:

Set-up & Tear-Down:

Doors will open at the Nationwide and Ohio Farm Bureau 4-H Center for **set-up** Friday, September 23 from 5:30pm-7:00pm and on Saturday, September 24 at 7:00am. Exhibits can remain in place overnight at the Center. Exhibitors should be at their exhibits no later than 8:00am on Saturday, Sept. 24th. All exhibits must be removed immediately upon adjournment on Saturday.

Loading & Unloading: There are parking spaces at the 4-H Center and across Fred Taylor Drive in the Bill Davis Stadium Lot, so parking is not an issue. After you register to be an Exhibitor, a link to a Reserved Parking Pass to print and put on your windshield will be sent to you.

Electrical outlets: Outlets are available. You should bring your own extension cords. Indicate if outlets are required.

Other Information for Staffing the Exhibits

Please have someone knowledgeable to staff the exhibit and be available to answer questions. You will have the opportunity to interact with participants before the opening plenary (8:30-10:00am); during a ten-minute break; during the lunch/Festival time (12:15-1:45) and during the workshop break from 2:45-3:00.

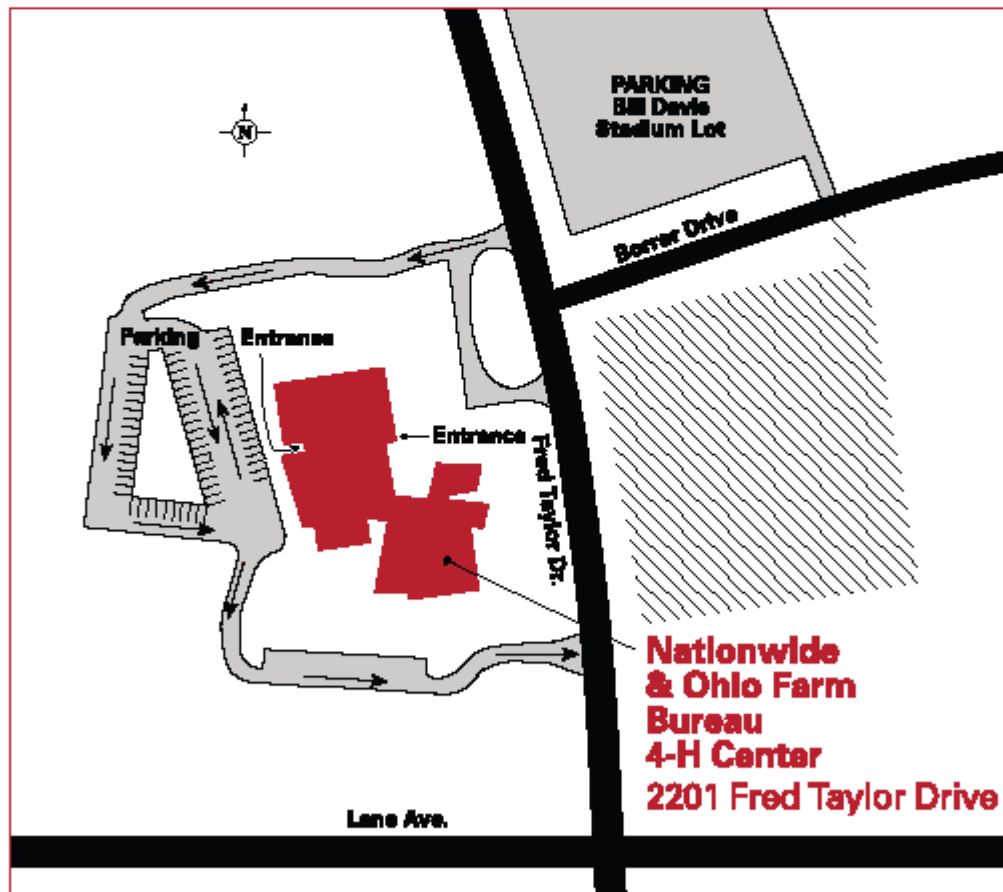

PARKING
