

Make a Banner Celebrating the Wonders of the Earth

We invite you to join the Ohio Interfaith Power & Light *Celebrating the Wonders of the Earth* display of banners. These banner panels will be a testament of what **we love about the Earth and want to protect from climate change and environmental disasters**. We will display these panels at the upcoming Earthkeeping Summit 2016 on September 24th. This could be a great project for a youth group, a quilting group, a study group, green teams, and individuals. The banners will be available after the Summit for a traveling display at local houses of worship and events.

Directions:



Cut a panel of sturdy cloth, double thickness, of any color, finished size 18" x 36".

Sew several rows of stitching as a border on all four sides to give the panel strength.

On this panel sew, paint, write, embroider, applique, weave, knit,

*tie dye or use crayons or ornaments of any kind to express **what you most love about the Earth and want to protect from climate change and environmental disasters**.*

Sew 9 inch (20cm) pieces of ribbon or bias tape to each corner so the banners may be easily tied together.

Write your name, address and any story/message on the back of your banner.
